## Fee Requirements and Finance Overview

There are a few fees that are required for your child to participate. We try to get all of the fees out of the way at the beginning of the season so we don't have to come back and ask for money later. All of the fees that are collected directly impact your player and help make their experience a good one.

- **Activity Fee** - There is a *mandatory \$150 activity fee that must be paid to Chaparral no later than August 26<sup>th</sup>*. Your player will not be allowed to practice or play if this fee is not paid by the date listed above. This fee is paid to the school. It can be paid at the Chaparral Bookstore or online through Register my Athlete. RMA puts payment through Touch Base Sign In. [www.az-scottsdale.intouchreceipting.com](http://www.az-scottsdale.intouchreceipting.com) The log in for this site is your student's student ID and the password they created for school log ins (usually their birthday). These fees are part of the Chaparral Athletic program operating costs and support expenses such as referees, required staff (score keepers, admissions, security, etc.), equipment, etc.
- **Varsity Fee** – Varsity players must pay the Varsity Fee of \$50. This fee covers the additional items that Varsity players receive which includes HUDL (stats and highlights), extra jersey, and personalized warm up jacket.
- **Booster Fee** - *Membership in the Booster Club must also be paid by August 26<sup>th</sup>. There are a few choices in the membership level that you can choose but membership is required. Booster Club memberships cover all of the activities that are provided to your player and the teams.* This is a 501(c)(3) entity, and your donation is tax deductible.

This fee helps cover costs for the following:

- Team gear - practice t-shirts, backpacks for new players, Dig Pink clothing, and uniforms
- Meals for home games – During home games, each team will have a table where their meal will be provided. JV and Varsity eat before their game and Frosh eats after their game.
- Team bonding activities – each team will have an activity that they complete together for team bonding prior to the first game.
- End of the year banquet – player tickets are provided with booster membership
- Team photos – group shots for each team for yearbook as well as varsity banners
- Game programs
- Senior Night
- Dig Pink Night
- Year-end gifts and awards



## Chaparral Volleyball Booster Club: 2022 Membership Options

### All Parents are required to have a Booster Club Membership

This membership covers the required items that are provided to your player during the season. Please review each membership listed below including the items covered in each membership. Some of the options below waive the “varsity fee” of \$50 to cover the cost of HUDL and additional gear. *Chaparral Firebirds Volleyball Boosters is a tax exempt 501(c)(3) organization. We are happy to provide you with a receipt for your sponsorship donation.*

#### ○ \$300 Bronze Level Sponsor

This sponsorship covers: Player gear, Team Bonding Activity, Team Photo, Meals for Home games, End of Season Banquet Ticket for Player, Year End Gifts and Awards, Game Programs, Senior Night and Teacher Appreciation Night. \*\*This sponsorship level does not include the Varsity fee. Varsity players will need to pay this booster fee plus the Varsity fee of \$50.

#### ○ \$500 Silver Level Sponsor

All of the program benefits listed in the Bronze Level, PLUS you will receive an extra set of practice jerseys, free drinks from the snack bar at home games, you will be listed in the program as a Silver Sponsor and your player will have a “cheer” board posted on the wall for Home games. Varsity fee will be waived if you select this membership level and your player is on the Varsity Team.

#### ○ \$750 Bird Cage Level Sponsor

All of the program benefits listed in the Bronze and Silver Levels, PLUS you will be listed as a Bird Cage Sponsor in the game program and receive two free tickets to the end of the year banquet held at the Orange Tree Golf Resort. Varsity fee will be waived if you select this level and your player is on the Varsity Team.

<b>Dig Pink</b>	3-4 people needed to help with raffle table on Dig Pink night	October 6
<b>Senior Night</b>	3 people needed to help put together senior boards and senior meal	
<b>End of Season Banquet Committee</b>	5 people needed to help plan the banquet – including set up and clean up.	The committee typically meets as a group 1-2/x to assign tasks and plan. Committee members arrive at the banquet early to set up. They stay after to help clean.
